Spicy Spiral Table Runner: This unique and wonderful project will “spice” up the conversation at your table. Use different color ranges and values from dark to light—eight fabrics. No one stops at making just one! It’s so fun you’ll make dozens of these fun and easy table runners! The Spicy Spiral Table Runner is made with the Ten Degree Wedge Tool! **Level: 100. When: Session 1:** Tuesdays, March 7th, 21st and 28th @1 to 4pm. **Session 2:** Tuesdays, March 7th, 21st and 28th @5:30 to 8:30pm! **Cost:** \$35 + supplies. **Teacher:** Cindi Fuselier



Once you assemble your blocks with sashing all there is left to do is the binding AND IT IS FINISHED!!!!!! Plus...yes there is more...the back of the quilt looks like a whole different quilt. So if you make a table runner, you can do one side with Christmas fabric and the other side with Thanksgiving fabric. Just think of all the possibilities!!!! **Level 100: When:** Saturdays, March 18 & April 1 @ 9:00 am to Noon. **Cost:** \$30 + supplies. **Teacher:** Peggy Gibson.

Long Arm Class I: Intro to the Handi Quilter Avante

Would you like to learn how to long arm? This class must be taken to rent the machine from Quilters Depot and a pre-requisite for Pro-stitcher.
