Big Block Quilt 2: Come join Pauline as she returns to this favorite quilt class. BQ2 is a maple Island Quilts. The BQ2 can be made in four different size. Choose a focal fabric and add coordinating colors and the blocks are done quickly! No border required to make this a quick quilt! **Level:** 200. **When:** Tuesday's, October 9th, and 16th @10:30 am to 1:30pm **Cost:** \$25 + pattern and supplies. **Teacher:** Pauline Shushnar



Iris Quilting: IRIS quilting is a technique developed by Marsha Gaasenbeek which features a unique arrangement of fabric pieces to create what she describes as swirling motion in each finished pattern. This class will be based upon her book of 16 different patterns. You will choose the design you prefer and create a block that can then be your focal point in a finished project – think pillow, framed piece, small hanging for wall or door, purse, runner, small quilt, vest back...up to you! Joan will

walk you through making the block you choose in the first and second sessions. The third session will be devoted to applying your block to a finished project. The sample shown has been finished by mounting it onto an artist's canvas block. Jenn has ordered a couple copies of the book off Amazon. Please register early. Price of book depends on Amazon but first copies are the same price. This is a THREE week class. **Level:** 300. **When:** Wednesdays, October 10th, 17th and 24th. **Session 1:** 1 to 4pm. **Session 2:** 5:30 to 8:30. **Cost:** \$30 + price of book and supplies. **Teacher:** Joan Kugler.

Make N Take: Circular Clutch: This clutch is a super quick idea! It can be any size you want from small enough to tuck in your purse to large enough to use as a cross-body or wristlet style. It requires just one or two fat quarters, a nylon zipper, a piece of iron-on interfacing or batting and a plate to trace around for your perfect circle. Joan will provide the pattern and instructions. This can be completed in an hour. There are a few new rules the Pro Stitcher students/renters need to pay attention to Our classes are meant to teach you the basics. If you want to do more advanced we can talk about getting you your own machine!

To Summarize:
Pro Sticher Rental is being increased to \$17/hour.

To take the Pro Stitcher class you will have to have quilted TWO quilts on the machine before you can take the Pro Stitcher class! NO exceptions.

The first time you rent the Pro Stitcher your quilt size and design will have to be approved by Jenn/Cynthia.

From a Sweet 16 Sit down model to the 26" Infinity; Handi Quilter and Quilters Depot will help you finish your quilts! To rent our machines all you have to do is take the class!

Have a Handi Quilter? We do service, updates and upgrades. Come talk to Jenn. Cynthia is our Tech! Would you like to Demo a machine before buying. Contact Jenn to arrange a time that you can

come in and play! Always watch your emails. Handi Quilter is always coming up with new sales!

Long Arm Class I: Intro to the Handi Quilter Amara:

Would you like to learn how to long arm? This class must be taken to rent the machine from Quilters Depot and a pre-requisite for Pro-stitcher. **When:** The usual schedule is Thursday evening, Friday Evening and Saturdays or whenever there are night classes and Jenn is on duty! Come in and talk to Jenn or email her to schedule your class! **Cost:** \$75.00.

Teacher: Jenn.



Misc. info: The classes will be one-on-one unless arranged differently with Jenn. I will supply batting and thread for the class. You will need two pieces of scrap fabric, a yard or less for front and back. I will also be providing you with an instruction manual to help you along

Long Arm Class II: Pro-Stitcher Premium

Come in and learn how to let the Pro Stitcher do the work for you. Ok, it is not that easy, but easier than you think!. Bring in two pieces of fabric, a yard each with the quilt top piece being 2 inches shorter all the way around. I suggest for this class you bring solid colors so you can see your designs!

Prerequisite: You must have taken the first long arm class so that you know how to use the basic machine! You must have rented twice before you can take this class. This will force you to know how to load and thread the machine and cut down on the time Jenn or Cynthia needs to spend with you. **When:** The usual schedule is Thursday evening, Friday Evening and Saturdays or whenever there are night classes and Jenn is on duty! Pro Stitcher is on it's premium edition! Jenn finally figured most of it out! Come in and talk to Jenn or email her to schedule your class! **Cost:** \$65.00. **Teacher:** Jenn

Long Arm Class III. Intro to the Handi Quilter Sweet Sixteen.

Are you not a stand up Quilter? Do you want to learn how to use the Handi Quilter Sit down model? **Cost:** \$25. **Teacher:** Staff

Long Arm Rentals: All rentals must be scheduled through Jenn and is upon availability and working schedule of Jenn and Cynthia.

Meandering: \$10/hour **Hours:** M, T, Fridays 10am to 6pm. Wednesday, 2pm to 6pm. Evening Hours Thursday, Friday and all day Saturday .

Prosticher Premium: \$17/hour **Hours:** M, T, Fridays 10am to 6pm) Wednesday, 2pm to 6pm. Evening Hours 5pm to 8pm Thursday, Friday and all day Saturday 9 am to 3pm!
